OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject : **Transfer of mandate of Films Division regarding Production of Documentary Films to National Film Development Corporation (NFDC) - Functional Integration under Production Vertical of NFDC - regarding.**

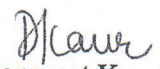
Reference is invited to the decision of the Government to merge four Film Media Units viz. Films Division, Directorate of Film Festivals (DFF), National Film Archive of India (NFAI) and Children's Film Society, India (CFSI) with National Film Development Corporation (NFDC).

2. In this context, the following has been decided:

- i. The mandate of Films Division for ‘Production of Documentary Films’ shall stand transferred to NFDC w.e.f. 01.04.2022. The Documentary Films shall henceforth be produced under the Production Vertical of NFDC.
- ii. The ongoing projects related to Production of Documentary Films, if any, shall be completed by Films Division as per their extant Rules and Regulations. No new projects for Production of Documentary Films shall be undertaken by Films Division henceforth.
- iii. Managing Director, NFDC shall assign a team headed by a suitable officer at appropriate level, under Production Vertical, for understanding the modalities involved in Production of Documentary Films.
- iv. Director General, Films Division shall plan and commence the knowledge transfer to NFDC, under Production Vertical, ensuring the transition of mandate of Production of Documentary Films to NFDC, with immediate effect.
- v. The revenue generated from the activities related to Production of Documentary Films shall accrue to NFDC and NFDC shall devise strategies to enhance revenue from the said activities.
- vi. The employees of Films Division involved in the activities related to Production of Filmic Content are hereby attached under Production Vertical of NFDC as a temporary arrangement until further orders.
- vii. MD, NFDC may utilize the services of employees to ensure that NFDC is able to successfully implement the mandate. This arrangement shall have no bearing on any of the service conditions of the employees. They shall continue to draw their salaries, allowances, TA/DA, etc. through Films Division.
- viii. The sub-unit of the Production Vertical in NFDC that undertakes activities related to production of documentaries and short films shall be named ‘Films Division’, in order to continue with the brand recognition of Films Division since 1948.

3. Director General, Films Division shall ensure compliance of the above-mentioned decisions within the specified timelines.

Subject: **Transfer of National Film Archive of India (NFAI) into National Film Development Corporation (NFDC) under Preservation Vertical of NFDC - regarding.**

Reference is invited to the decision of the Government to merge four Film Media Units viz. Films Division, Directorate of Film Festivals (DFF), National Film Archive of India (NFAI) and Children's Film Society, India (CFSI) with National Film Development Corporation (NFDC) and this Ministry's O.M. of even number dated 24.12.2021.

2. In this context, the following has been decided:
 - i. The entire mandate of NFAI stands transferred to NFDC under the Preservation Vertical w.e.f. 1st April, 2022.
 - ii. The employees of NFAI are hereby attached under Preservation Vertical of NFDC w.e.f. 1st April, 2022 as a temporary arrangement until further orders. MD, NFDC may utilize their services to ensure that NFDC is able to successfully implement the mandate. This arrangement shall have no bearing on any of the service conditions of the employees. They shall continue to draw their salaries, allowances, TA/DA, etc. through NFAI.
 - iii. The additional charge to the post of Director, NFAI is hereby assigned to Shri Ravinder Bhakar, CEO, CBFC in addition to his regular duties, with immediate effect and until further orders. He will be entitled to draw any additional remuneration on account of holding the aforementioned additional charge as per extant orders of the Ministry of Finance.
 - iv. Shri Prakash Magdum stands relieved of his duties from the post of Director, NFAI with immediate effect. He is directed to report back to his parent cadre.
 - v. Shri Guruprasad H.L. also stands relieved of his duties from the post of Deputy Director, NFAI with immediate effect. He is directed to report back to his parent cadre.
3. Director, NFAI and MD, NFDC shall ensure compliance of the above-mentioned decisions within the specified timelines.

Subject: Transfer of mandate of DFF regarding Organization of International Film Festival of India (IFFI) to National Film Development Corporation (NFDC) - Functional Integration under Promotion Vertical of NFDC - regarding.

Reference is invited to the decision of the Government to merge four Film Media Units viz. Films Division, Directorate of Film Festivals (DFF), National Film Archive of India (NFAI) and Children's Film Society, India (CFSI) with National Film Development Corporation (NFDC).

2. In this context, the following has been decided:
 - i. The mandate of DFF to organize International Film Festival of India (IFFI) stands transferred to NFDC with immediate effect. 53rd edition of IFFI to be held in November, 2022 shall be organized by NFDC under its Promotion Vertical.
 - ii. All other activities conducted by DFF shall be transferred to NFDC w.e.f. 1st July, 2022.
 - iii. The employees of DFF are hereby attached under Promotion Vertical of NFDC as a temporary arrangement until further orders. MD, NFDC may utilize their services to ensure that NFDC is able to successfully implement the mandate. This arrangement shall have no bearing on any of the service conditions of the employees. They shall continue to draw their salaries, allowances, TA/DA etc. through DFF.
 - iv. ADG, DFF shall ensure that the transition of mandate of Organization of IFFI is smooth and without difficulty.
