- Pioneered the wide use of ORS (Oral Rehydration Solution), estimated to have saved over 5 crore lives globally
- ORS is a simple, inexpensive yet effective ingenious solution - thanks to which the world has witnessed 93% reduction in deaths caused by Diarrhea, Cholera & Dehydration, especially in infants & children
- He demonstrated the effectiveness of ORS while serving in **Refugee** camps during the 1971 Bangladesh Liberation War, having returned from USA to serve

- Closely observed & documented their
 culture and tradition in his book called




Ramkuiwangbe Newme


Jaivik Kheti ke Prerak

- Reduced dependency of farmers on Agrochemical industry
- Engaged in farming with his wife Benu Maya
 Upreti, now deceased

- Nau Anaj is a natural intercropping method in which 9 food grains are grown on the same piece of land, without any chemical usage, cutting down water usage by 50% and raising land fertility
- Inspiring other farmers to follow the same
- Also producing local indigenous seeds, distributing to more than 10,000 farmers in 6 states at no cost


Dhaniram Toto

Triumph of Dengka

- Toto (Dengka) language preserver from Totopara village of Jalpaiguri district
- Despite lacking any formal training as a Linguist, he is the architect of the Toto language script, preserving the indigenous language
- The language now has 37 alphabets
- First author to write a novel in Toto language
- Toto (Dengka), is a dying language listed as highly endangered by UNESCO

- Created a new music genre named Howey and another instrument called Tikzik

- Leads artists showcasing the traditional instrument across the state & nation
- Started playing Thamate at age 16, and now trains young and upcoming artists, despite the social stigma attached to it




Bhanubhai Chitara
